











March 2020 Unique Learning System Curriculum: All About Light and Sound

	<p>color</p>	<p>What you see when light bounces off different objects, such as red, yellow or blue</p>
	<p>echo</p>	<p>A repeating sound you hear that is made by sound waves bouncing off an object</p>
	<p>energy</p>	<p>The power to do something</p>
	<p>light</p>	<p>A type of energy that lets us see</p>
	<p>Light wave</p>	<p>An invisible wave that moves light energy</p>
	<p>reflect</p>	<p>To bounce of something</p>
	<p>sound</p>	<p>A type of energy that lets us hear</p>
	<p>Sound wave</p>	<p>An invisible wave caused by vibrations that move sound energy</p>
	<p>vibration</p>	<p>A small, fast movement that goes back and forth</p>
