A Mother Hugging Her Daughter and Holding a Mother's Day Card

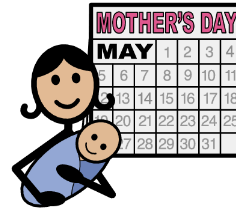
